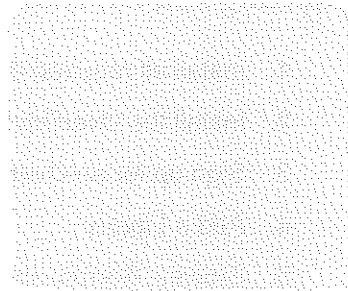


What is the OverDrive Media Console App?

The OverDrive Media Console App is designed for mobile devices like smartphones and tablets. It provides library patrons on-the-go access to eBooks and Audiobooks.

Getting started is Easy

1. Install all required device updates.
2. Install the OverDrive App from the App store on your device
3. Sign up for an OverDrive Account/Adobe ID
4. Add a Library
5. Browse, Borrow and Download

Install the OverDrive App

1. Go to the **App Store** on your device.
2. Tap **Search** and then search for **OverDrive Media Console**.
3. Tap **Install**.
4. Tap **Open**.

Authorize with an OverDrive Account/Adobe ID

The first time you launch the OverDrive App or attempt to download an eBook, you will be prompted to Sign In/Sign Up for an OverDrive Account or Sign In with an Adobe ID.

- When you create an account on your device, it will automatically authorize your device so you can start reading eBooks right away.
- You will be prompted to sign in or sign up with an OverDrive Account when you install the latest version of OverDrive for Android, iOS, or Windows 8.
- When you create an account on your device, it will automatically authorize your device so you can start reading eBooks right away.
- You may also authorize the most up-to-date version of the OverDrive app (3.2) with an Adobe ID, but we recommend using your OverDrive Account to authorize instead.

Note: When you create an account, you'll be asked to verify your email address. To complete the process, click the link we send you in your verification email.

If you have an Adobe ID:

- Launch the **OverDrive App**.
- Tap **Sign In**.
- Enter your **Adobe ID** and **password**.
- Tap **Authorize**.

If you don't have an Adobe ID:

- Launch the **OverDrive App**.
- Tap **Register at Adobe.com**.
- Set up an Adobe ID (requires a valid email address).
- Go back to the OverDrive App.
- Tap **Sign In**.
- Enter your **Adobe ID** and **password**.
- Tap **Authorize**.

Note: If the Adobe Sign-in screen is no longer available, go to the App settings to authorize.

To Add a Library

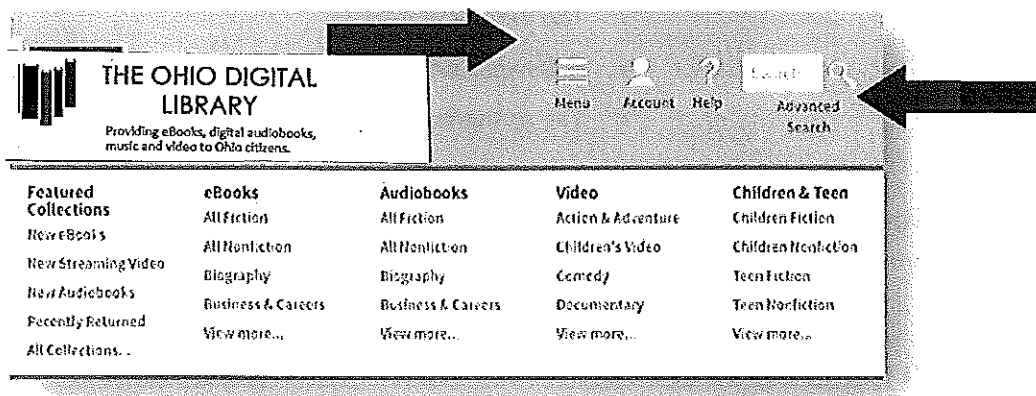
1. Tap **Get Books**.
2. Tap **Add a Library**.
3. Enter a library name, city or zip code.
4. Tap **Search**.
5. Select a local library from the search results.
6. Tap the **Star** symbol to save the library.

To Login

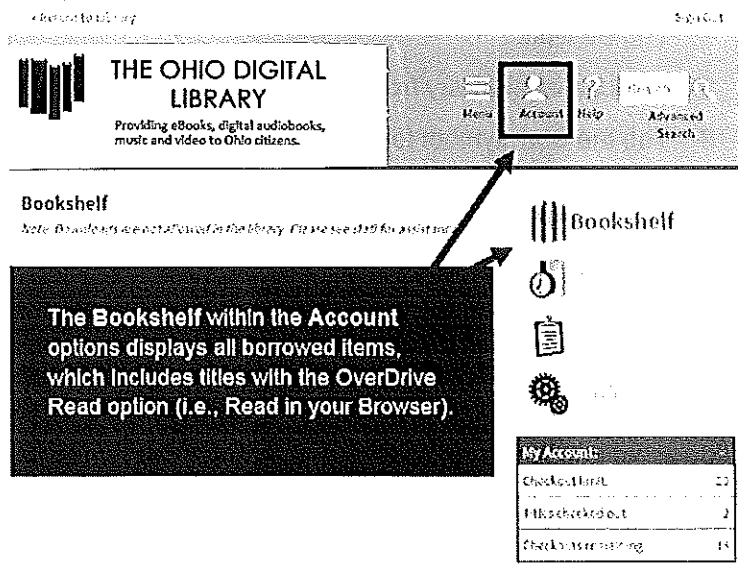
1. Go to **Account**.
2. Enter your **Library card number** and **PIN**.
3. Tap **Sign In**.

To Browse / Search

- Tap Menu: To browse by format or category.
- Tap Advanced Search: To search for a specific title/author, format, or subject



Bookshelf



The Bookshelf within the App menu options displays downloaded titles.

Note: The menu button may look different depending on your device.

Features Overview:

- o **Menu:** Displays formats and categories.
- o **Account:** Access borrowed items, wish lists, holds and settings.
- o **Help:** Find answers to your questions, watch how-to videos.
- o **Advanced Search:** Best search method for specific title/author, format, or subject.

Note: Depending on the mobile device and/or settings, the magnifying glass needs to be tapped if you do not see Advanced Search.

Display of Search Results:

Customize your results view (cover or list) using the buttons in the upper-right corner of the screen.

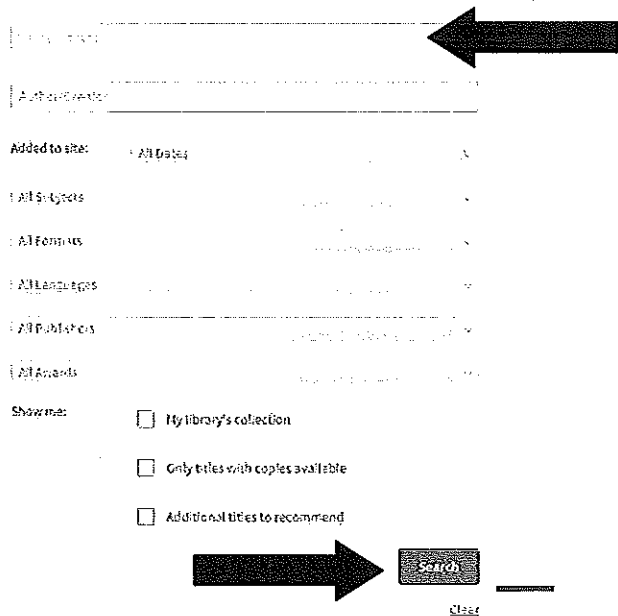
- o **Cover View**
- o **List View**



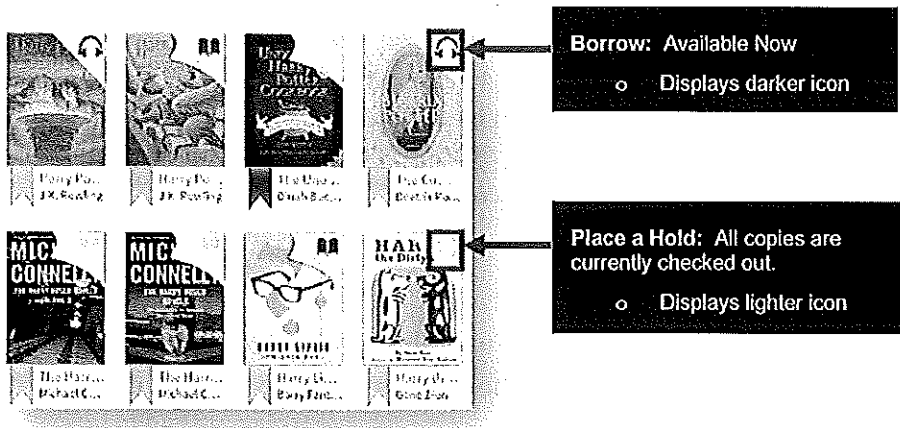
Advanced Search

- o Search for a Title or Author
- o Search by Subject or Format
- o Search by Language or Publisher
- o Search by My library's collection
- o Search by Awards
- o Search by Available Titles
